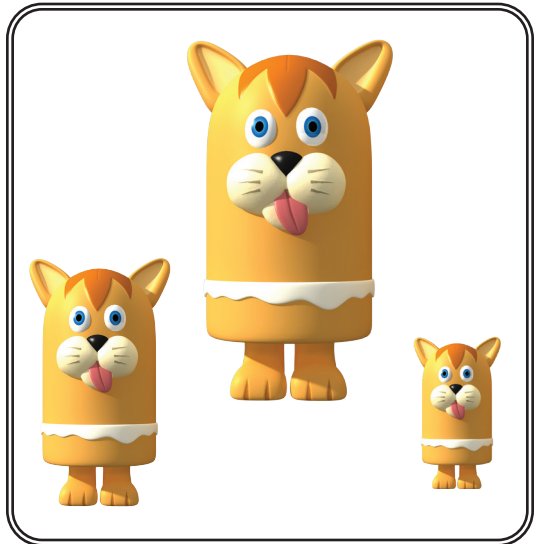
# SOFT OR HARD?

Name each item. Circle the items that are **soft**. Cross out the items that are **hard**.



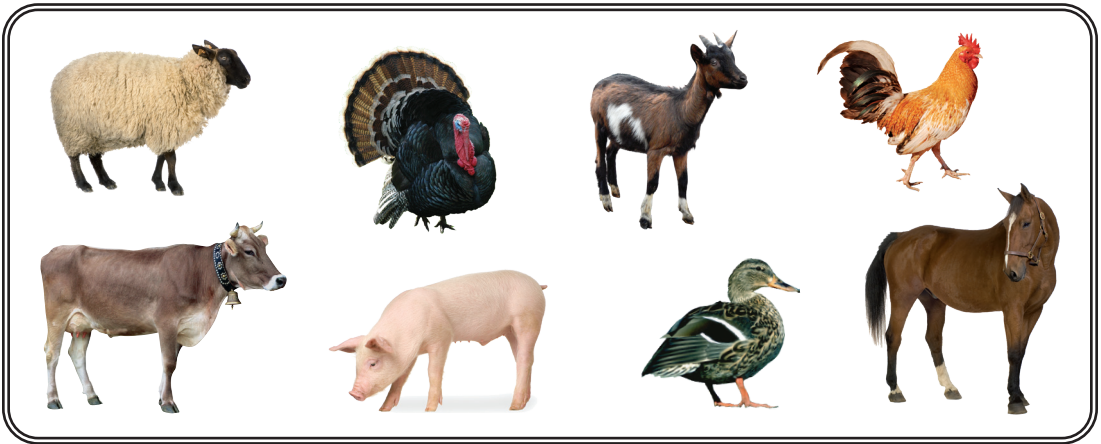
# LARGEST AND SMALLEST
